- 78 family units served (98 adults, 82 children, and 58 seniors) for a total of 248 individual clients. There was one emergency during this month.
- 86 children served through the Weekend Children's program.
- Ziegels donated 208 lbs. of food this month, along with many needed items for the Blessings Room.
